

**omiv news - february 2015**

**1- INSU**

- 2015 INSU funding of the SNO-OMIV: 75 k€ (idem 2014). 8 k€ was forwarded to each of the scientist in charge of the 4 OMIV sites. This year there was no meeting to discuss the yearly funding for each SNO at INSU. The documents which correspond to the detailed funding request for 2015 are available through the OMIV website. During the meeting in Paris on November 10, 2014, each TERre Interne SNO presented the prospective for the next 4 years (OMIV file available on the OMIV Website - news section).

**2- INSU**

- White paper by INSU on Telluric risk with implication of each person in charge of TI-SNO. Started in late december 2014, this INSU initiative to build up of reflexion group on the topics "hazard and risk associated with telluric phenomena on the french territory (observation, monitoring and alert)"

**3- OMIV data per site**

- new seismological antenna, La Clapière december 2014
- new hydro-meteo devices at Séchilienne and Avignonet
- solar panels at one of the Séchilienne stations stolen, to be replaced

**4- OMIV data per observable**

- Seismology: on-going validation for a DOI (Digital Object Identifier) on continuous seismic data. These data are currently stored on the RESIF infrastructure and available through the RESIF portal.

**5- OMIV staff**

- Application for cnap position should be encouraged by each partners; (As of today, known candidates are: C. Hibert (EOST-IPGS), N. Lesparre (OCA-geoazur), M. Radiquet (OSUG-ISTerre).
- 3 year limit (University/INSU CNRS short-term contract rule) for IE CDD seismology, corresponds to an end of contract in June 2015. ISTerre-OSUG-INSU are currently working on the possibility to extend to a 4th year.
